The Championship shall consist of 54 holes of individual stroke play, to be played under Rule 3, Stroke Play. The maximum handicap index for this competition will be 40.4. The Age Divisions (as of the first day of the Championship) are:

If two sets of tees are used, the Super Seniors and the Masters will play from the shorter set for all three days.

Division winners shall be the low gross scorers in each of the (7) divisions. Other division prizes shall be awarded as determined by the Tournament Committee. Number and composition of flights, within the Age Divisions, shall be determined by the Tournament Committee. Prizes shall be awarded on both gross and net scores. A perpetual trophy is awarded to the Champion.

Special Prizes:

- 1) The Mary Lou Sauer Memorial Trophy shall be awarded to the member club, which has any two of its participants with the lowest combined net score. **An individual's club affiliation must be received by the Tournament Operations Manager five business days before the start of the Championship.**
- 2) The Mo Cruikshank Memorial Trophy shall be awarded to the member club which has any two of its participants with the lowest combined gross score. **An individual's club affiliation must be received by the Tournament Operations Manager five business days before the start of the Championship.**
- 3) The Legends Championship Trophy- **Gross** shall be awarded to the lowest gross scorer of the Super Seniors and Masters Divisions combined.
- 4) The Legends Championship Trophy- **Net** shall be awarded to the lowest net scorer of the Super Seniors and Masters Divisions combined.

Starting time: 8:30 a.m. shotgun start each day

Field size: If enough entries are received, both the north and the south courses will be used (older age divisions to play the south course). Age division course assignments will be made on Tuesday, September 29, 2009. Players will be notified as to which course they will be playing at that time in their acceptance letters.

Practice rounds will be available at a rate of \$41 before 1:00pm and \$27 after 1:00pm for Friday, October 16, 2009. For Saturday, October 17, 2009 practice rounds are available at a rate of \$46 before 1:00pm and \$32 after 1:00pm. Rates include cart. Practice round tee-times can be made up to 7 days in advance by calling 520-776-7888. Players are encouraged to check the golf course website at www.antelopehillsgolf.com for rates on other days.

Entry fee of \$180 per player will include green fees, cart fees, range balls, tee prizes and awards luncheon following play on final day. Entrants must use an official entry form available in the 2010 AWGA Directory, or on the AWGA web page at www.awga.org.

Registration will be held Saturday, Oct. 17 from 12:00 to 3:00 p.m. and Sunday, Oct. 18 from 7:00 to 8:00 a.m.

Exemptions into tournaments: All past AWGA board members who have fulfilled their term of office will be exempt for the number of years served. All current board members who have served at least one year will be exempt. A two-year exemption is granted for the overall gross and net winners of the tournament.

Eligibility: The tournament is open to senior amateur golfers (age 50 and older) who have a USGA Handicap Index of 40.4 or lower and are AWGA members in good standing for at least 30 days prior to the first day of the tournament.
